**Registration** may be completed by mailing the enclosed registration form along with payment to:

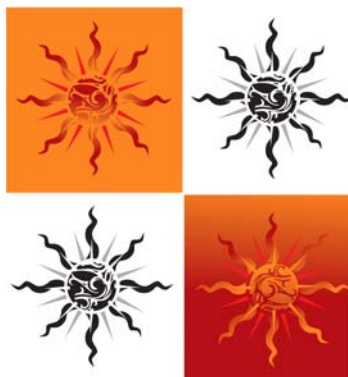

A separate registration is required for each child registering. Camps may be paid for by cash, check, or credit card. Checks should be made out to Allen Academy with student's name and activity written on the memo line.

When your registration is submitted, you will receive a confirmation by email (or by USPS when no email is available) which will list all the camps for which you registered, a Release Form which you will need to sign and bring with you on the first day of camp, and the amount paid. You should keep a copy of this for your records.

**Refund Policy:** Camps and Classes need a minimum number of participants enrolled in order for it to begin. If you need to cancel for some reason prior to June 1, 2009, you will receive the amount paid, minus a \$30 administrative fee for each camp/class registered. After June 1, your money will be refunded in full only if a class is cancelled or if there is a medical reason or family emergency that prevents your student from attending the camp. Allen Academy reserves the right to cancel any course for which there is insufficient enrollment.

**Meals and snacks:** Students are encouraged, at the discretion of the camp director, to bring a snack or lunch to Allen with them depending upon the duration of their time at Allen. There will be no food or drink allowed in the academic building. For an additional \$25, students may purchase lunch on a weekly basis. This fee cannot be divided, nor will there be more than one choice provided on a daily basis.



## CAMP ALLEN: AN AMERICAN ADVENTURE!

Grab your bag and let's go!!! Join a fun and talented group of travel guides as you travel around the United States--without ever having to leave Texas! This year's summer camp promises to provide a world of activity! Campers will navigate the Mississippi River, climb Mt. Rushmore, and visit the San Diego Zoo! The daily schedule will include time for learning, fun games, physical activity, crafts, and dramatic interpretations. Field trips to swim, play, learn, and explore will also be offered throughout the summer. It's sure to be an adventure!

This adventure is open to campers **ages 4-14**. Campers will be divided into age appropriate groups for each activity.

**Hours:** Campers may be dropped off beginning at 7:30 am and must be picked up by 5:30 pm, but may be picked up prior to that time. Camp activities officially begin at 8:30 am, so all campers should be present by that time. Additional early morning activities will be provided for those attending from 7:30-8:30 am.

Campers can choose an entire day's stay or come for half a day. Campers may bring a sack lunch OR purchase lunch weekly at an additional cost if desired.

**Weeks:** Beginning Monday, June 8, camp will run on a weekly basis through Friday, August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2009. Campers can register for as many weeks as desired. **Activities will differ each week.** Weeks must be paid for in full regardless of whether a camper attends all five days or not.



**Cost:** Choose the option that's right for you:

Option I	7:30 am-5:30 pm (50 hours)	\$150 per week (includes snacks)
Option II	7:30am-5:30 pm Lunch provided	\$175 per week (includes snacks)
Option III	7:30 am-12:30 pm only (25 hours)	\$ 90 per week (includes snack)
Option IV	12:30 pm-5:30 pm only (25 hours)	\$ 90 per week (includes snack)

Campers may also choose to participate in another camp at Allen during the day at the additional camp cost. The counselors will make sure campers are delivered to and returned from their additional camp on time. Those taking part in additional camps or classes may have to miss certain activities of Camp Allen. Campers will be supervised at all times.

Cost includes a camp T-shirt.

## Activity Camps

The following camps are being offered at Allen during the week(s) and time(s) listed. Please also note the ages allowed to enroll in each camp.

**Cost is \$125 per camp unless otherwise noted.**

### ART CAMP (Ages 7-12 years old)

Van Gogh? Picasso? YOU? Bring out your creative side at Allen's Art Camp! Students will be looking at works and styles of art throughout history beginning with ancient Egypt and going up to modern times. We will learn the techniques of these various periods using several different media (colored pencils, oil pastels, chalk pastels, pen and ink, watercolors, printmaking). Class includes some art history and slide viewing. Cost includes supplies.

### BASKETBALL CAMP (Rising 4-8<sup>th</sup> Grade Students)

Session I June 22-26 1-4 pm

Session II June 29- July 3 1-4 pm

Coming off a successful first year as Allen Academy's middle school basketball coach, Donald Hamilton will help students break down the game and improve their offensive as well as defensive skills. Coach Hamilton played point guard at Angelina Jr. College and Midwestern State. While there, his team won back to back Conference Championships. In high school, Coach Hamilton earned All-District and All-State honors.

Depending upon the number of camp participants, players will also learn team strategies and play lead up games as well as participate in a camp tournament. Each session is limited to 25 students. This camp is open to boys and girls. Cost includes a camp T-shirt.

Each session is limited to 10 students. Additional sessions may be added. Cost includes necessary materials.

Coach Coe played three years of collegiate volleyball at Rhodes College in Memphis, TN, helping the team win the school's first volleyball conference championship her senior season.

Whether a beginner or an experienced Middle School volleyball player, this will be a week of fundamental development. Skills will be broken down and practiced through instruction and repetition. Lead up games as well as six on six games will be played throughout the week. This camp is open to boys or girls.
