

Spanish III (Full year) Course Description

Prerequisites: Spanish I and II, or instructor approval upon completion of placement test.

Spanish III is the last course required to graduate and builds upon previously learned skills and emphasizes increased accuracy. Students will continue their progress toward mastery of the present and preterit tenses, as well as with the imperfect, perfect, future and subjunctive. Other tenses such as the perfect tenses will be explored throughout the year. The emphasis on vocabulary expansion and more advanced writing, listening and reading tasks will enable the students to better negotiate communicative tasks. Spanish is the primary vehicle for classroom communication. Field trips to Hispanic Community Places may be offered subject to School administration approval.

If the student wants to continue learning the Spanish Language, the World Language department suggests taking Spanish IV Pre-AP.
