

Spanish III Pre-AP (Full year) Course Description

Prerequisites: Spanish I and II, or instructor approval upon completion of placement test.

This course serves as a bridge between the first two years of basic language instruction and prerequisite for the more advanced courses offered in the Spanish program. Language instruction will continue to expand the students' four skills: listening, speaking, reading and writing as well as gain a deeper understanding of Latin American cultures. Emphasis is also placed on more advanced grammatical structures and practical interpersonal activities. In order to prepare students for the next level, use of broadcast media and online resources from Spanish speaking countries are used as students acquire the necessary skills. This course is designed for students who plan to take the Advanced Placement Exam in Spanish. Field trips to Hispanic Community Places may be offered subject to School administration approval.

If the student wants to continue learning the Spanish Language, the World Language department suggests taking Spanish IV Pre-AP after the successful completion of this course.
